Through our Open Gardens program, KLFS plants and maintains 78 raised garden beds in Lindsay that provide free, fresh produce to those that need it. The Summer Lunch Outreach Program is another important initiative we facilitate with help from partnerships with other local organizations to provide free, healthy lunches to elementary-aged children in need throughout summer months.
